Our school's reading and math data were presented on. We have seen lots of growth in Math, and are currently at our End of Year goals in both growth and proficiency for each grade level based on last year's scores. We will continue to work on this, and we know at the end of the year we will have great growth, we are also hanging in with the district in our scores. Our reading data will continue to be worked on for the remainder of the year. At our data meetings, plans were made for next steps. These plans include ensuring that students are spending more time in text each day. In the upper grades, we will continue to focus on the connection to writing.

Review School needs and propose 2024 - 2025 Sunset Trust Land Expenditure Plan:

It was proposed that we use Trustland funds to continue with programs and personnel already in place. Continuing to fund additional hours for our counselor to address the social and emotional needs of our students along with a paraprofessional to run our Wellness Center. We would continue to fund salaries for our Take Home Librarian, Art teacher and one of our kindergarten paraprofessionals. Funds would also be used for art supplies and a choir stipend. Last years plan was as follows:

- .20 Counselor: \$20,640
- Wellness Center Paraprofessional: \$18,561
- Art Paraprofessional: \$13,649
- .50 Kindergarten Paraprofessional: \$13,649
- Take Home Librarian: \$7,445
- Art Supplies: \$1,000
- Choir Stipend: \$1,000
- Remainder: Contingency

Total amount: \$73,187.97

Committee was encouraged to think about this proposal and talk with friends and neighbors to determine if any changes, adjustments and/or additions should be made. The 2024 - 2025 plan will be finalized at our next meeting.
