We have seen lots of growth in Math, and are currently at our End of Year goals in both growth and proficiency for each grade level based on last year's scores. We will continue to work on this, and we know at the end of the year we will have great growth, we are also hanging in with the district in our scores.

Our reading data will continue to be worked on for the remainder of the year. At our data meetings, plans were made for next steps. These plans include ensuring that students are spending more time in text each day. In the upper grades, we will continue to focus on the connection to writing.

All 4th and 5th grade teams will achieve a median growth score of 40% or higher according to RISE. 70% of kindergarten and first grade students will be blue in EOY Acadience.

**PEERS Goal #3** - 75% or more of students will achieve proficiency in science and/or show at least a year's worth of growth. All 5th grade teams will achieve a median growth score of 40% or higher according to RISE.
